Dear Parent/Legal Guardian:

Our district will be administering a new student survey entitled *Building Tomorrow: A Culture and Climate Partnership Survey*. There are seven subsets to the survey: Student Respect, Understand Rules, Follow Rules, Adult Respect, Safety, Learning and Tobacco/Alcohol/Drugs/Violence. The purpose of the survey is to help the school understand how the students feel about school, other students, adults in the school and their experiences with tobacco, alcohol, drugs and violence. All survey responses are confidential; students will not put their name on the survey. The survey takes approximately 15-20 minutes to complete and is taken on the computer during the school day. The data obtained from this survey will help the school develop a focus to improve school safety and climate. The results will be reported by building, grade level and subgroups.

The school will be conducting this survey with all students in grades 11 during second semester. You, as a parent or legal guardian, have the right to review the survey.
